Job Title: Food Service Associate; part-time cook

Job Description:

In addition to the practical knowledge required for the position of regularly serving meals exceeding a count of over 399, the successful candidate will possess empathy and patience for those in need and those disciples we work alongside of, obtain superior customer service skills and a commitment to creating a welcoming experience as well as preparing quality meals in a rapidly changing environment. This person must be able to

- Cook food according to menus or special dietary needs according to large amounts needed.
- Complete prep work includes cleaning, cutting, and cooking various meats, fruits, vegetables, etc. in accordance with proper meal handling techniques.
- Provide excellence in how we plate, serve and present our food. Facility needs to include cleaning the dining hall, food service equipment, dishes, pots.
- Knowledge in training in sanitation, equipment and food safety is required. And familiarity of rotating inventory on a first in, first out basis.

Though your primary responsibility is cooking as part of food service you may be asked to complete the following

- Transporting meals on a daily basis
- Catering meals or events onsite or offsite
- Warehouse – sorting, rotating, assist in various daily required operational needs

Requirements:

A servant's heart to serve the least, the last and the lost

Class C Driver's License / Clean driving record

High School diploma required or equivalent experience

Food Handler's certificate/permit

2+ years' experience cooking

Food preparation experience

Ability to work in a fast-paced/ high-capacity environment

Excellent communication, time management and organizational skills

Ability to work a flexible schedule such as overtime and weekend work may be required, as well as special events and holidays.

Must be able to work with grills, ovens, and stovetops

Must be able to carry, lift, push, pull up to 50 pounds regularly and bend and stoop
